CPF helps turn New York City's parks into centers of community development, while helping to create strong local leaders. The majority of our programming is provided at no cost, and we work in neighborhoods that would not otherwise have access to such resources. Reporting to the Director of Institutional Advancement, this position is responsible for securing foundation funding, competitive government grants and corporate philanthropy in support of CPF's Education and Partnerships for Parks programming and resources.

*Education:* Sequential environmental science programs—from elementary to high school—in urban ecology (garden, forest, water and marine) with instructional time, outdoor learning, assessment and use of digital technology both in and out of school.

**Partnerships for Parks:** This unique program supports and champions a growing network of leaders caring and advocating for neighborhood parks and green spaces. We equip people and organizations with the skills and tools they need to transform spaces into dynamic community assets.
