POSITION SUMMARY

City Parks Foundation is the only independent, nonprofit organization whose mission is to offer programs in parks throughout NYC's five boroughs. We work in more than 300 parks, recreation centers, and public schools citywide, presenting a broad range of programs in an effort to promote healthy and vibrant communities. CityParks Golf offers free lessons to 3,500 participants at 11 parks and numerous golf facilities citywide and has made the sport more accessible for urban youth in the city. In 2008, CPF opened the *CityParks Junior Golf Center*, a \$8,000,000 state-of-the-art training facility in Brooklyn that provides free lessons and playing time exclusively for NYC children. In addition to the facility in Brooklyn, CPF operates a Junior Golf Center annex at the Flushing Meadows Corona Park Pitch and Putt. The facility has a 5 stall netted driving range and practice green where lessons are held. In 2018, CPF will be partnering with the First Tee of Metropolitan NY to incorporate its PLAYER life skills curriculum into the CityParks Golf, Junior Golf Center and Annex programs

CPF is seeking to hire experienced players, coaches or PE teachers to provide free lessons to beginner and intermediate level junior golfers ages 7-17 at the Golf Center Annex in Flushing Meadows Park. Lessons are generally held on Saturdays / Sundays from 9am - 4:30pm. Instructors will be trained by the Annex Director to teach a standardized curriculum developed by City Parks Foundation and The First Tee, and will be members of CPF's Sports Department.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Demonstrate and teach daily lesson plans
- Organize large groups of children in an orderly and safe manner
- May be required to carry equipment to/from sites
- Monitor weekly attendance and maintain accurate records of class participants
- Answer questions from parents and promote whenever possible to the community

REQUIREMENTS

- Advanced playing ability and thorough knowledge of golf rules and etiquette
- Prior experience teaching golf in both private and/or group setting
- Ability to work with diverse constituencies, both internal and external to CPF
- Exceptional communication skills and work-ethic
- Willingness and ability to carry and transport sports equipment as needed
