A "Marionette Touring Company" was founded in 1939 by Parks Commissioner Robert Moses, and in 1947, the Swedish Cottage Marionette Theatre became home to the Company. A permanent theater was constructed inside the Cottage in 1973, precisely designed for marionette performances. Since then, hundreds of thousands of children and families have enjoyed its original marionette productions. Under the direction of City Parks Foundation, the Swedish Cottage Marionette Theatre, as well as its traveling extension, the CityParks PuppetMobile, continue to entertain audiences throughout New York City.

POSITION SUMMARY

The temporary, part-time puppeteer will be required to perform in productions at the theater and in the outdoor mobile unit. Additional duties (listed below) may be done upon request. Training will be provided. This position will require approximately 15 hours per week. Puppeteers must have a flexible schedule, and must be able to work some weekends.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform marionette puppet shows at theatre and mobile unit
- Participate in build/breakdown of mobile stage in various outdoor locations
- Drive PuppetMobile (sprinter van) throughout 5 boroughs of NYC when needed
- Greet and interact with audience members in a respectful and professional manner
- Occasional ushering and box office duties at theatre when needed
- Assist with production builds and tear downs as needed
- Act as ambassador for the organization, answering questions for audience members about the Marionette Theatre and CPF

REQUIREMENTS

- Experience as a performer
- Familiarity with puppetry. Marionette experience a plus.
- Ability to take direction, to work in a team, and in a fast-paced environment
- Available to work a minimum of 15-hours per week, including some weekend shifts
- Valid driver's license, clean driving record, and willingness to drive van throughout New York City
- Ability to lift and carry up to 30 lbs of equipment and scenery
- Ability to work outdoors (includes under direct sunlight and light rain)
- Experience working with children a plus
