POSITION SUMMARY

We are seeking individuals to assist in administering surveys during free SummerStage performances throughout the five boroughs. Surveyors will be paid \$15/hour, plus \$2 for each survey collected beyond 15 surveys. Performances usually run for 2 hours. The daily quota per surveyor is 25, so the expected income per event is \$50, but can be higher if surveyors surpass the quota. The dates and locations are as follows:

- Ensure that all surveys are properly labeled with date, park, artist details, and surveyor information
- Return all completed surveys to Front of House Manager
