A permanent theater was constructed inside the Cottage in 1973, precisely designed for marionette performances. Since then, hundreds of thousands of children and families have enjoyed its original marionette productions. Under the direction of City Parks Foundation, the Swedish Cottage Marionette Theatre, as well as its traveling extension, the CityParks PuppetMobile, continue to entertain audiences throughout New York City.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Swedish Cottage Marionette Theatre Puppeteer is a part-time, hourly position. The primary function of the Puppeteer is to perform as a marionettist, and to contribute to overall theater production process --set-builds, puppet and props creation, costume-making, front of house operations, and/or general housekeeping. Marionette puppetry skills a plus, but not a prerequisite. Training will be provided.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES





- Perform marionette puppet shows at theatre
- Complete training sessions as mandated by artistic director
- Greet/usher and interact with audience members in a respectful and professional manner
- Contribute to production process via set building, scenery and props creation, costume design and sewing, and/or set up and teardown.
- Assist in box office and general theater duties when necessary
- Act as an ambassador for the organization, answering questions for audience members about the Marionette Theatre and CPF

QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience with puppetry
- Experience as an actor, physical theater, dance, or other theater arts
- Availability to work a minimum of twelve (12) hours per week in November and December, and a minimum of nine (9) hours per week in January and February
- Ability to work two weekend days per month
- Ability to take direction, pick up blocking quickly, and work in a team in a fast-paced environment
- Ability to work with children
- Ability to lift and carry up to 50lbs of equipment and scenery
