April 23, 2025 -- New York, NY -- City Parks Foundation is thrilled to announce the 2025 season of Capital One City Parks Foundation SummerStage, New York City's iconic outdoor performing arts festival, bringing more than 70 free and benefit shows to Central Park and 13 neighborhood parks across the five boroughs. Returning for its 39th year, the festival will once again showcase established and emerging artists, highlighting an expansive array of talent, from diverse performances from across the globe to artists serving



as curators to iconic DJs showcasing cultural sonic journeys. The robust lineup will feature a multitude of genres including jazz, hip-hop, indie-rock, salsa, reggae, Afrobeat, soul, pop, global, contemporary dance, and more. **View the official SummerStage 2025 season announcement video** <u>here</u> **and the full season brochure** <u>here</u>.

Neighborhood parks hosting SummerStage this season include Marcus Garvey Park in Harlem, Tompkins Square Park in the East Village, Herbert Von King Park and The Coney Island Amphitheater in Brooklyn, Flushing Meadows-Corona Park in Queens, St. Mary's Park and Crotona Park in the Bronx, Stapleton Waterfront Park on Staten Island, and SummerStage's flagship venue Rumsey Playfield in Central Park. Performances will be free and open to the public, with the exception of ticketed benefit concerts in Central Park. More information is available at <u>www.SummerStage.org</u>.

"I am thrilled to announce our 2025 SummerStage lineup, a stellar reflection of what makes our festival so unique and beloved," said **Heather Lubov, Executive Director of City Parks Foundation**. "The huge variety of artists we're presenting and the parks where we're located reflect our city's demographic and cultural diversity, but they also serve to unite us as neighbors and as lovers of music, regardless of our differences."

This year's festival will continue to champion our city's diversity, uplift women performers, and bring artists from across the globe to New York City. **Opening the 2025 season on Wednesday**, **June 4** in **Central Park** will be an exuberant free show bringing the genre-blending rhythms of New Orleans to NYC. The show will be headlined by illustrious two time GRAMMY-winning jazz bassist, multi-instrumentalist and composer **Marcus Miller**, and will also include performances by the dynamic GRAMMY-winning New Orleans R&B soul/funk group **Tank and the Bangas**, and New Orleans' high-energy eight-piece brass ensemble fusing funk, jazz and hip-hop, **The Soul Rebels**.

The season's free shows in Central Park will spotlight an incredible array of artists from around the world. **THE AUSSIE BBQ** will return on June 14 featuring the latest sounds from down under including father and son hip-hop duo **Flewnt and Inkabee**, hypnotic indie-pop artist **Gordi**, compelling singer-songwriter **Grace Cummings**, electronic music duo **PINES**, garage rock trio **The Grogans**, and a special appearance from the iconic children's music group **The Wiggles**; on June 15, we will welcome our first Nordic sounds showcase **Nordic Next** treating fans to a sampling of sounds including soulful Norwegian indie-pop singer-songwriter **Jakob**, Swedish indie-folk singer **Sarah Klang** and Danish art-pop violist and singer-songwriter **Astrid Sonne**. **New York Sings Yiddish** will return on June 30 showcasing Yiddish music and folklore with performances by leading Yiddish musician/multi-instrumentalist **Zalmen Mlotek** and world-renowned klezmer/jazz fusion group **Frank London's Klezmer All Stars**; while GRAMMY-nominated Toronto R&B singer-songwriter **Charlotte Day Wilson** and acclaimed Canadian folk-rock band **The Weather Station** will provide a taste of Canada's music scene on July 2.

The annual Latin Alternative Music Conference (LAMC) will return to Central Park for two



performances: on July 9 with Colombian Latin pop band **Morat** alongside punk-reggaeton band **Planta Industrial**, and on July 12 with acclaimed Colombian singer-songwriter and six-time Latin GRAMMY winner **Camilo** and Colombian pop singer and Latin GRAMMY 2024 Best New Artist winner **Ela Taubert**. The sounds of France will take center stage on July 13 celebrating **Bastille Day**, showcasing performances by veteran French house DJ **Bob Sinclar**, hip-hop brother duo **Big Flo & Oli**, popular singer-songwriter and actor **Patrick Bruel**, and pianist and singer-songwriter **ESTL**.

One of the season's standout shows will be on July 27, when groundbreaking Nigerian global music superstar **Femi Kuti** - eldest son of Afrobeat pioneer Fela Kuti - will take the stage with his celebrated group **The Positive Force** for an electrifying performance. Joining the show are hip-hop legends **dead prez**, in celebration of their 30th anniversary, and poet **Maryam Bukar Hassan**.

On August 3, **Taiwanese Waves** will present a mix of music and dance celebrating indigenous Taiwan culture including contemporary dance company **Bulareyaung Dance Company**, top indigenous Paiwan pop star **ABAO**, and ethereal singer-songwriter **Enno Cheng.** Additional highlights this season include esteemed dance company **Ballet Hispanico** on August 7; Academy Award-winning actor and icon **Morgan Freeman** presenting **Morgan Freeman's Symphonic Blues**, showcasing classic Delta Blues hits backed by a symphony orchestra on August 2; internationally acclaimed Brazilian singer **IZA** on August 31; Japanese hip-hop star **Awich** on September 14; and two tour de force indie-rockers, **Soccer Mommy** and **Hurray for the Riff Raff**, on September 16.

SummerStage shows in neighborhood parks will include performances at Herbert Von King Park in Brooklyn's Bedford-Stuyvesant neighborhood with New Orleans bounce queen **Big Freedia** performing her dynamic new gospel/rap/bounce project, paired with Black trans femme choreographer - and legend in the ballroom community - **Courtney "Balenciaga" Washington's MasterZ at Work** on July 10. Trailblazing Philadelphia hip-hop band (and beloved house band of "The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon") **The Roots** will perform at Flushing Meadows-Corona Park in Queens on July 20, and in the Bronx's Crotona Park, tropical/salsa star **Frankie Negrón** will perform on July 31. New York's legendary and highly influential hip-hop MC **Rakim** will hit the stage at Stapleton Waterfront Park on Staten Island on August 9, and the legendary and influential salsa band from Puerto Rico, **La Sonora Ponceña**, will bring their classic rhythms to Stapleton Waterfront Park on August 10.

"It's a joy to program a festival that authentically celebrates New York City and the diverse communities we serve. We strive each summer to collaborate with artists and curate shows to honor cultural movements, artistic communities, and the current sounds and styles that resonate with New Yorkers." said **Erika Elliott, Executive Artistic Director of SummerStage.** "We are extremely proud of the 2025 season, with this year's programming giving a platform to artists and communities to celebrate the vibrant tapestry and cultural landscape of our city. From jazz to hip-hop and everything in between, we're thrilled to bring these performances to the heart of each borough, celebrating the distinctly artistic expression that



makes our city so unique."

SummerStage is giving artists and DJs expanded opportunities to collaborate as curating partners, putting their stamp on SummerStage showcases. **MIKE'S Young World V** will feature two leading underground hip-hop impresarios and collaborators **ROC Marciano & The Alchemist** (with other guests to be announced on July 12) in Brooklyn's Herbert Von King Park; **DJ Rekha will return** to Flushing Meadows-Corona Park in Queens to create her iconic **Basement Bhangra Beyond** dance show with London-based Punjabi singer-songwriter **Tara Lily** and more on July 19; Coney Island local **NEMS** will present the second iteration of his hip-hop festival **GORILLAFEST** on July 26; **Funk Flex** will celebrate the sounds of hip-hop and R&B across the boroughs with several shows (the Bronx on August 1, Coney Island on August 16, and Central Park on August 17); and renowned DJ, producer, and visionary artist **King Britt** will bring his innovative **Blacktronika Festival** with back-to-back, stacked performances in Central Park on August 16 and Marcus Garvey Park on August 17.

SummerStage will continue to amplify women in music, with the 2025 season showcasing new female artists igniting the scene and veterans who continue to pave the way. In Central Park, Bluegrass and Americana powerhouse **Rhiannon Giddens** will bring a rockin' show to Central Park on June 25; celebrated Indian-American singer-songwriter **Asha Puthli** will play on July 23; and folk singer **Jessica Pratt** will bring her distinct style on July 24. The **Celia Cruz Celebration** will pay tribute to the legendary Queen of Salsa's centennial on August 9 with performances by Latin GRAMMY and GRAMMY-winning Cuban singer, pianist and actress **Aymée Nuviola**, who also portrayed Celia Cruz in the Colombian telenovela "Celia," and noted Afro-Cuban singer and multi-instrumentalist **Brenda Navarrete.** To close out the free season in Central Park, **Soccer Mommy** will bring her indie-pop sound for a show alongside **Hurray for the Riff Raff** and **Dummy.**

SummerStage will return to **The Coney Island Amphitheater** in Brooklyn this summer for six free shows. In addition to NEMS Presents: GORILLAFEST and the Funk Flex Birthday Day Party, the lineup will also include veteran funk/jazz band **Lettuce** with **Styles P** on June 14, salsa singer **Tony Vega** on August 8, and the annual **Chol Hamoed Spectacular: The Yeshiva Boys Choir** on October 9.

The **Charlie Parker Jazz Festival**, New York City's annual salute to the eponymous late saxophonist, will return for its 33rd year as a three-day celebration of live jazz in the neighborhoods near where Parker worked and lived, Harlem's historic **Marcus Garvey Park** and **Tompkins Square Park** in the East Village. Running August 22 - 24, the festival will feature a blend of renowned artists alongside an emerging wave of jazz performers, including the prolific jazz bassist **Ron Carter's Great Big Band**, trumpet player and multi-instrumentalist **Nicholas Payton**, accomplished jazz pianist **Bertha Hope Quintet**, rising jazz vocalist **Georgia Heers**, legendary TONY and GRAMMY-winning jazz vocalist **Dee Dee Bridgewater** with celebrated jazz pianist **Bill Charlap**, brilliant jazz saxophonist and his influential jazz group **Gary Bartz: NTU Troop**, and the noted NYC jazz ensemble **The Jazz Gallery All-Stars**, among others. Additional jazz events will be held across the city, with



more performers to be announced in the coming months.

The 2025 SummerStage season will also feature **ticketed benefit shows in Central Park** to help underwrite the festival's free performances. Live Nation, the official producer of SummerStage benefit concerts, will present Trinidadian soca singer **Patrice Roberts** on May 17; Norwegian DJ and record producer **Alan Walker** on May 31; South American supergroup **Astropical** (Bomba Estereo and Rawayana) on June 1; reggaeton singer **Yandel** performing with a live orchestra on June 7; musical duo **The Driver Era** on June 9; English singer-songwriter **James Blunt** and Canadian singer and songwriter **Forest Blakk** on June 17; rapper **Noname** and R&B singer **Ravyn Lenae** honoring Juneteenth on June 18; Trinidadian soca group **KES** on July 5 and July 6 (both are sold out); Christian singer-songwriter **Chris Tomlin** on July 11; Irish rock band **The Saw Doctors** on July 26; Indie-folk band **The Head & The Heart** on July 30; English singer-songwriter **Jacob Collier** on August 1; Indie-rock band **Rilo Kiley** on September 8 (sold out), and others to be announced.

As a women-run festival with a mission to reflect the diversity of our city and its residents, SummerStage has helped to transform the future of the music industry by participating in the PRS Foundation's international Keychange pledge since 2019, presenting an annual lineup that features at minimum a 50:50 gender balance. SummerStage is one of the few local festivals that has achieved this goal through their commitment to diversity in its programming and a consistent, year-over-year minimum of 50% BIPOC and non-male identifying artists.

This four show series will kick off on opening night with **Marcus Miller** on June 4 and continue on July 26 with **The Saw Doctors**, on July 27 with **Femi Kuti & The Positive Force**, and culminate on July 30 with **The Head & The Heart**.
